A BALANCED APPROACH

MATTHEW 25:1-13

»	The parable of the faithful and wise servant versus the wicked servant (24:45-51) teaches us to be prepared in case Jesus comes than we expect.	
»	The parable of the bridesmaids (25:1-13) teaches us to be prepared in case Jesus longer than we think He will.	
	Both attitudes are necessary for us to have a balanced hope in Christ's return.

- 6. How does it make you feel to know that Jesus is preparing a place for you in His Father's house? In what way is Jesus preparing you to be with Him?
