- 4. Read 1 Corinthians 4:1-2. How did Paul and his coworkers wish to be regarded? Above all else, why do you think God requires faithfulness from his servants?
- 5. Read John 7:21-24. How did the Jews' opposition to healing on the Sabbath prove that they were "judging by mere appearances"?
- 6. How can you be a better steward of what God has already given you? What can you expect from the Lord if you use your resources for His glory?
