ROMANS 12:9-21

- 1. What kinds of barriers separate people in our society? How can social, economic, ethnic, etc. barriers be removed?
- 2. Read Ephesians 2:11-18. In verses 11-12, Paul uses at least five terms to describe the unbeliever's spiritual condition. What are they?
- 3. Answer these quick hit questions based on the passage above: What has Jesus done? What did Christ abolish? What was the result? Who were the recipients of Christ's message of peace?
- 4. Read Ephesians 2:19-22. How do the images Paul uses in this passage emphasize the unity Christians have with one another?
- 5. Finding your answers in the passage above, how does the gospel break down religious, social, and ethnic barriers? In Christ, what is every Christian's relationship to other Christians?
- 6. Read Romans 12:9-21. What do you think it means to "honor one another above yourselves"? How would being "joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer" affect your relationship with others? How are the instructions in these verses particularly helpful when it comes to living at peace with everyone regardless of ethnicity?
