#### LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION:

- 1. The Spirit brings life to every Christian at the moment of conversion. What were some early signs of life when you became a Christian?
- 2. As you look back on your Christian life, has your understanding of the Holy Spirit changed? If so, explain.
- 3. Read Romans 8:1-4. What is the resounding good news that Paul declares here?
- 4. The written Law of the Old Testament is powerless to enable us to obey God or attain life—it cannot free us from sin and death. How has God done what the Law is powerless to do (verses 2-3)?
- 5. Read Romans 8:5-11. Paul divides all of humanity into 2 categories: those who live according to the flesh (sinful nature) and those who live according to the Spirit. In your own words, what are some characteristics of each group? According to verse 9, how do we know which category we are in?
- 6. There are many professing Christians whose lives seem different from Paul's description of life in the Spirit. How do you think Paul would account for this fact? What evidence do you see of your life being controlled by the Spirit?
- 7. According to Paul, what role does the mind play in a life of sin or a life of righteousness (verses 5-8; see also Romans 12:2)? How have you observed the role of the mind in your own combat with sin?
